Graduated in 2003 with a thesis on the work of the German intellectual Hans Mayer at the Institute of Philosophy, Vienna. Publications include prose, poetry, and essays in periodicals and anthologies, and for radio broadcast. His plays have been staged in Austrian, German and US theaters. He has been publishing books since 2003. Clemens Berger lives and works as a freelance writer in Vienna and southern Burgenland. He has taught literature at the University Mozarteum Salzburg from 2010 until 2016. He is co-editor of *Versopolis*, *The European Review of Poetry, Books and Culture*, a pan-European online literary magazine.
